## Boston College Freshman Natalie Crutchfield Named Co-ACC Player of the Week

### Crutchfield's game-winning goal vs. No. 3 Virginia earns her Player of the Week Honors

College women's soccer team, shared co-ACC Player of the Week honors with Wake Forest's Jill Hutchinson this week as announced by the conference office.

Crutchfield, a native of Acton, came up big on Sunday as her goal helped the Eagles stun No. 3 Virginia, 1-0, in an ACC match. Crutchfield, who earned her first start of the season, scored at 87:12 in the game off a nice pass from sophomore [Gina DiMartino](#).

It was Crutchfield's second career goal and second game-winning goal of the season. She now has two goals and four assists for eight points. She notched her first goal of the season on September 6 in a 2-0 victory over Brown University.

Boston College (10-3-3) will travel to Maryland this week to take on the Terrapins on Thursday, Nov. 1 at 7 p.m. The Eagles, who have two conference games remaining, are currently in sixth place in the conference with a 3-3-2 record.

The Eagles are currently ranked 16th in the nation by Soccer Buzz and No. 1 in the Soccer Buzz Northeast Region poll. Soccer America has the Eagles currently ranked 11th in this week's poll. The NSCAA poll will be released on Tuesday. The Eagles were ranked 14th in last week's poll.
