8 Statesmen honored by Liberty League



GENEVA, N. Y.—Seven Hobart College soccer student-athletes were named to the All-Liberty League Men's Soccer teams today, as voted on by the league's coaches. Junior goalkeeper Pete Van Dellon (Webster Thomas/Webster, N.Y.) was named to the first team, while junior forward Tyler Webster (Acton-Boxboro/Acton, Mass.), junior forward Dan Riso (Red Hook/Red Hook, N.Y.), junior midfielder Philipp Schoeniger (Erlangen/Erlangen, Germany), and junior defender Matt Schwartz (Lower Merion/Wynnewood, Pa.) all earned second team honors. Senior midfielder Brad Weinberg (Marcellus/Marcellus, N.Y.), sophomore midfielder Tom Moulton (Providence Country Day/Coventry, R.I.), and sophomore midfielder Sam Wisner (Wayland/Wayland, Mass.) were named to the honorable mention list.

Van Dellon posted an 8-1-2 record in goal with four shutouts and a 1.03 goals against average this season. He ranks fifth in the league in shutouts, and sixth in saves (47) and saves per game (3.92). Van Dellon picked up a season-high seven saves in a scoreless double-overtime draw against nationally-ranked St. Lawrence, and was named the Liberty League Defensive Performer of the Week once.

Webster leads the league in game-winning goals with six. He has tallied eight times this season, ranking him third in the league in goals and points per game (1.23), and fourth in points (16). Webster was tabbed the league's Offensive Performer of the Week twice this fall.

Riso ranks second on the team in scoring with five goals and an assist. He shares the eighth spot in the league in points (11) and ranks seventh in goals. Riso registered a goal and an assist in Hobart's victory over Utica, and scored the game-winner against Worcester State.

On defense, Schwartz leads a solid Hobart unit that ranks second in the league in shots allowed per game (9.81) and shots on goal allowed (80), and ranks fourth in goals allowed (18) and goals against average (1.08). He assisted on the game-winning goal in the Statesmen's win over Keene State, and tallied once himself in a victory over Utica.

Schoeniger ranks second on the team in assists with three. He set up the game-winning goal against Hamilton, and netted a goal in Hobart's win over Elmira. Schoeniger's ability to see the whole field and create offense has been a key component of this Statesmen team.
