Gayowski's first varsity goal was scored after he took a cross from Sam Kelly. D.J. Brock's save on a counterattack at the end of the first half helped preserve the shutout for the Colonials, who improved to 2-0-2.

On Friday, A-B earned its first win of the season, defeating Tyngsboro, 3-1. After the Tigers took an early lead in the 20th minute, A-B's Jay Hayward scored his first of two goals in the 28th minute to tie the game.

In the second half, Hayward sent a low cross toward Dan Sincavage, who put the ball into the net with his left foot. With three minutes remaining, Hayward scored with an assist from Jake Hart.
