

## [HAYLEY BROCK NETS HONOR](#)

The Gatorade Company, in partnership with RISE Magazine, today announced **Hayley Brock** of Acton-Boxborough Regional High School as its 2007-08 Gatorade Massachusetts Girls Soccer Player of the Year. Brock is the first Gatorade Massachusetts Girls Soccer Player of the Year chosen from Acton-Boxborough Regional High School.

The 5-foot-10 sophomore midfielder scored 24 goals and added seven assists this past fall, leading the Colonials (23-0-1) to the Division 1 state championship. A Boston Herald All-Scholastic selection, Brock scored three game-winning goals in five postseason contests, including a 2-0 sectional title victory over Winchester and a 2-1 overtime win against Weymouth in the state semifinals. She also earned First Team All-State and First Team All-New England honors this fall.

Brock has maintained a B average in the classroom. She participates in multiple community-service initiatives, volunteering to raise awareness about breast-cancer in addition to fund-raising via the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life. Brock also assists as an instructor at area youth soccer and basketball programs.

"Her distinguishing characteristic is her athleticism," said **Alicia Carillo**, head coach at Lincoln-Sudbury. "It defines her as a player. She has a hyper-speed that's just supersonic. Once she's able to create a gap, it's all over. In addition to her athleticism, she has the beginnings of a tactical awareness that makes her even more dangerous. And she has the will to score. She accepts the responsibility to get it done for her team."
