The undefeated Colonials have yet to give up a goal this year and rode to a 3-0 halftime lead on two goals from Cassie Wagner, in the 4th and 34th minutes, and one from Hayley Brock, in the 19th. Brock tallied again in the 46th for the final goal as A-B converted on four of six shots while holding South to only three.

Junior forward Bridget Dahlberg played well up front and senior defender Dani Pensack enjoyed a strong game in the back for South (3-2, 3-2 DCL).
